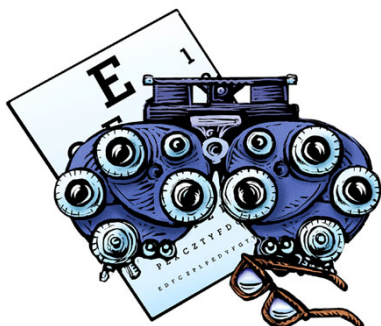


Refraction Fee
